



Important safety instructions

1. Read these instructions.
2. Keep these instructions.
3. Heed all warnings.
4. Follow all instructions.
5. Do not use this apparatus near water.
6. Clean only with dry cloth.
7. Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
8. Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
9. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarised or grounding-type plug. A polarised plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong are provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
10. Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.
11. Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer


3.0 Introduction

These quick start instructions describe how to configure the S7 Mini NetServer with 2 zones of an S7 NetAmp. Please refer to the detailed instructions available on the Systemline website for other configuration, connectivity and mounting options.

4.0 Connections

1. Use an Ethernet patch cable (not supplied) to plug the Local Area Network connection of the NetServer/Mini NetServer and NetAmp into the router network sockets. The router should have an active DHCP server (automatically assigning IP addresses).
2. Use two USB A-B cables (supplied) insert both into the NetServer or Mini NetServer's rear USB sockets and plug the other end into USB inputs 3 and 3A on the NetAmp.
3. Use the green IMO speaker connections (included), terminate the speaker cables making sure there are no strands or wire touching between the two terminations and plug into the speaker connections on the NetAmp.
4. Plug in the mains cable for the NetAmp and it will automatically switch on.
Please note: It is important that the NetAmp is switched on Before the Server.
5. Plug in the NetServer/ Mini NetServer's power supply and switch on from the front or via the top.

5.0 Set up server inputs on NetAmp

- Once booted up you can find the IP address of the NetServer using a FREE App called 'Fing' available from the Apple App store for iOS devices. Alternatively use a Network scanning program on your PC or Android phone such as Advanced IP scanner.
- Scan the Network that the Server is attached to, you should find the Server labelled as S7_NETSERVER.



- Open a Web Browser on your computer and type the IP address listed e.g 192.168.6.100 into the top bar followed by the return key.

4. Press the *Configure Player* button.

Each NetAmp USB socket has a unique serial number; they should be listed down the left side of the table and then an assigned MAC address next to it.



5. Press the *Select* button on the front of the NetAmp to display its' IP address.



6. Open up another page on the web browser and enter the IP address of the NetAmp.

e.g. enter: 192.168.6.101 then press return

7. Press *Source Setup* and you will be prompted to enter a user name and password. By default these are set as follows:

User Name: admin

Password: password

This process must be completed for the App to operate and show the correct zones.

8. You must obtain the MAC address associated with source 3 and 3A from the server. This ensures that the server and S7 App always link together and the correct audio stream is delivered to the correct zone.
9. Type in the IP address of the NetServer discovered in section 5.1 in the NetServer IP box at the bottom of the page then press Get MAC Addresses. The page will refresh and you will see the MAC addresses populate under Source 3 and Source 3A. If the Mac addresses do not populate then the IP address of the NetServer or Mini NetServer has not been entered incorrectly.

You will find that the MAC address that gets populated, corresponds to the MAC address listed on the NetServer or Mini NetServer Configure Player page, but using lower case letters, this is correct so please do not edit it!

This ensures that the server always uses the same player MAC address ID each time it is powered up or reconnected. It also ensures the App associates the server player ID with the NetAmp zone name.

10. You must press the Save button to save the settings.
11. If you have any other sources connected to the system such as an airport express or turntable, these can be named and added into Source 1 or Source 2 on this page.

6.0 Name the zones

1. Press Zone 1 Setup on the NetAmp web page.

2. Rename the zone by entering text and press Save.
3. Repeat the process for Zone 2.

7.0 Rip a CD

1. Plug a USB CD drive into a USB socket on the NetServer or Mini NetServer.
2. Insert a CD. Ripping will automatically start. An internet connection is needed for the server to find album, artist, track and cover art information.
3. When the CD has finished ripping, it will eject.
4. Repeat steps 7.2 and 7.3 for a number of CDs.


Note: If you know how to transfer electronically stored music from one device to another, you may also use this method to load content. In this case, the files should be placed in the folder \files\music\flac

5. Press System Configuration on the NetServer web page.
6. Press Reboot and then OK when prompted. This will re-boot the server and initiate a music database rescan. The Server will take 2 or 3 minutes to re-start.

8.0 Use the App

1. Download the Systemline 7 App from the App Store and open it.
2. Select a zone by pressing on the zone name.
3. Press the house button to open the full browsing page.
4. Select *Albums* from the list and then select an album to play.
5. Adjust the volume from the *now playing* screen.
